Learning objectives The aim of this course is to mark out the peculiarities and expressive resources in Catalan and Spanish and to acquire translation habits concerning different text types (narrative, descriptive, expository, argumentative and instructive) reflecting different degrees of structural complexity and linguistic variation (mode, field and style).
