ERASMUS+ BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME SECURITY RISK MANAGEMENT

Dates of the course: 7.-11.05.2024.

Place: Turiba University, Riga, Latvia

About the course:

The world is coping with a wide range of challenges such as migration, cyber-attacks, organized crime and other new challenges, including a recent (current) virus-led crisis. In the past years these challenges have also become security issues of importance to many European countries. Security challenges are important for any organisation or company, so experienced and well trained security specialists are vital for development of any company.

At the moment it is clear that European countries deal with these challenges in different ways. There are no unified standards and approaches as to how specialists should deal with these kinds of challenges. There is a need for professional, well trained specialists who can realize sound security risk management at various levels and in different kinds of organizations.

During the intensive course students will have the opportunity to learn about security risk management, develop skills, and gain knowledge about planning and implementing security management in various organizations. They will also learn about identifying and managing security risks. Of course, security education also requires practical knowledge and cooperation, so the course will include practical activities such as team challenges and exercises, and other activities that can be crucial factors in real situations.

There will be 3 introduction on-line lectures where students will get to know other participants and will participate in lectures about security basics and security risk management. Dates: 11.04.; 18.04.; 25.04.2024, afternoon from 16:00- 17:30, Eastern European Time (EET).

Students will receive **3 ECTS** for the course.

Participants – bachelor and master students of Security and Business field, any other students interested in security risk management topic. 5 students from partner Universities (having ERAMUS+ cooperation agreement with Turiba University).

Costs – Turiba University will cover accommodation costs in Students' hostel (2 bedded rooms), study programme, study visits, teaching materials and lecture costs.

Travel and stay costs must be financed from the partner University ERAMUS+ mobility grant.
