## Instructions regarding email, video and interview Access to the menció d'anglès (TEFL: Teaching English as a Foreign Language)

There are 2 ways to demonstrate that the candidate has a C1 level of English: 1) officially documented accreditation (see webpage). These are submitted to gestió acadèmica. (PREFERRED OPTION. ENTRY IS GUARANTEED).

2) faculty members related to the programme will carry out revisions of texts and videos and invite potential candidates for an interview in June (2025).

## Regarding the second option:

Interested candidates should send an email to the coordinator of the TEFL programme with this subject title: Video for TEFL (year): Name *Example: Video for TEFL (2025): Lola González* 

Note: Candidates should use the email function: **'request delivery receipt'** when you send the email.

The body of the email should explain the candidate's reasons (motivation) for applying for the programme. It should be no less than 2 paragraphs, no more than 5.

General Content (suggestion):

- Personal introduction (brief 1-2 sentences)
- Explanation of interest in joining the TEFL program (e.g. interests or experiences)
- One key strength or skill that you can bring to the program and why it is a contribution to the programme.

**NOTE:** the programme coordination is looking to hear candidate's PERSONAL VOICES and experiences. Emails and video dialogues that seem to be overly dependent on AI-generated content do NOT work in candidate's favour.

The candidate should send an **UNLISTED link** to an introductory video (youtube, Vimeo or similar). In the video, the candidate will explain their motivations for entering the programme, their trajectory and connections to the target language (English) and/or teaching/learning experiences that are pertinent to becoming an English as a Foreign Language teacher.

The email and video link must be received by the coordinator by **May 16th, 2025** (midnight).

Indications for the video:

- The candidate must be visible in the video.
- The video should not be longer than 2 and half minutes.

Following this preliminary phase, selected candidates will be interviewed by a panel of teachers from the TEFL programme. These will be held from **9-12 am on June 3rd and 9-12 am / 3 to 5 pm on the June 4th**.

Candidates will be informed of the time and place for their interview by May 23rd, 2025.
