

Introduction

This document is a summary of the instructions currently in force at the UAB.

Case management

Please inform of **any outbreak** affecting the **people who work** at the UAB: teaching and research staff, administration and services staff, and external company staff.

Remember that for the purposes of notification an epidemic outbreak is considered to be the appearance of 3 or more confirmed cases in a common working area during the 10 days before the date of the first symptoms or diagnosis (if there are no symptoms) of the last case to be identified.

Students who have been infected should inform their course coordinator. Course coordinators must continue to keep a record of cases, but it is no longer necessary to make regular reports to the University Health Service through the deans of school directors, except in cases which involve an outbreak within the same class group in a maximum period of 3 consecutive days.

If you have mild symptoms of respiratory infection, please use your mask, keep social interaction to a minimum and avoid all contact with vulnerable people (the over 60s, the immunosuppressed, pregnancies, etc.).

Use of masks

The use of masks will remain obligatory in the following cases:

- At the University Health Service.(SAS)
- For people with respiratory symptoms.

Responsible use of masks is especially recommended for vulnerable people (the over 60s, the immunosuppressed, pregnancies, etc.).

Hand cleaning

As a general measure, please ensure that you regularly wash your hands and apply sanitiser.

Ventilation

There are no complementary measures over and above the usual recommendations for well ventilated spaces and good hygiene practices.

Signing

Signing related to hand cleansing will only be maintained in certain spaces for the purpose of good practice, and signs for the use of face masks will be kept in spaces where this is obligatory (such as the SAS).
