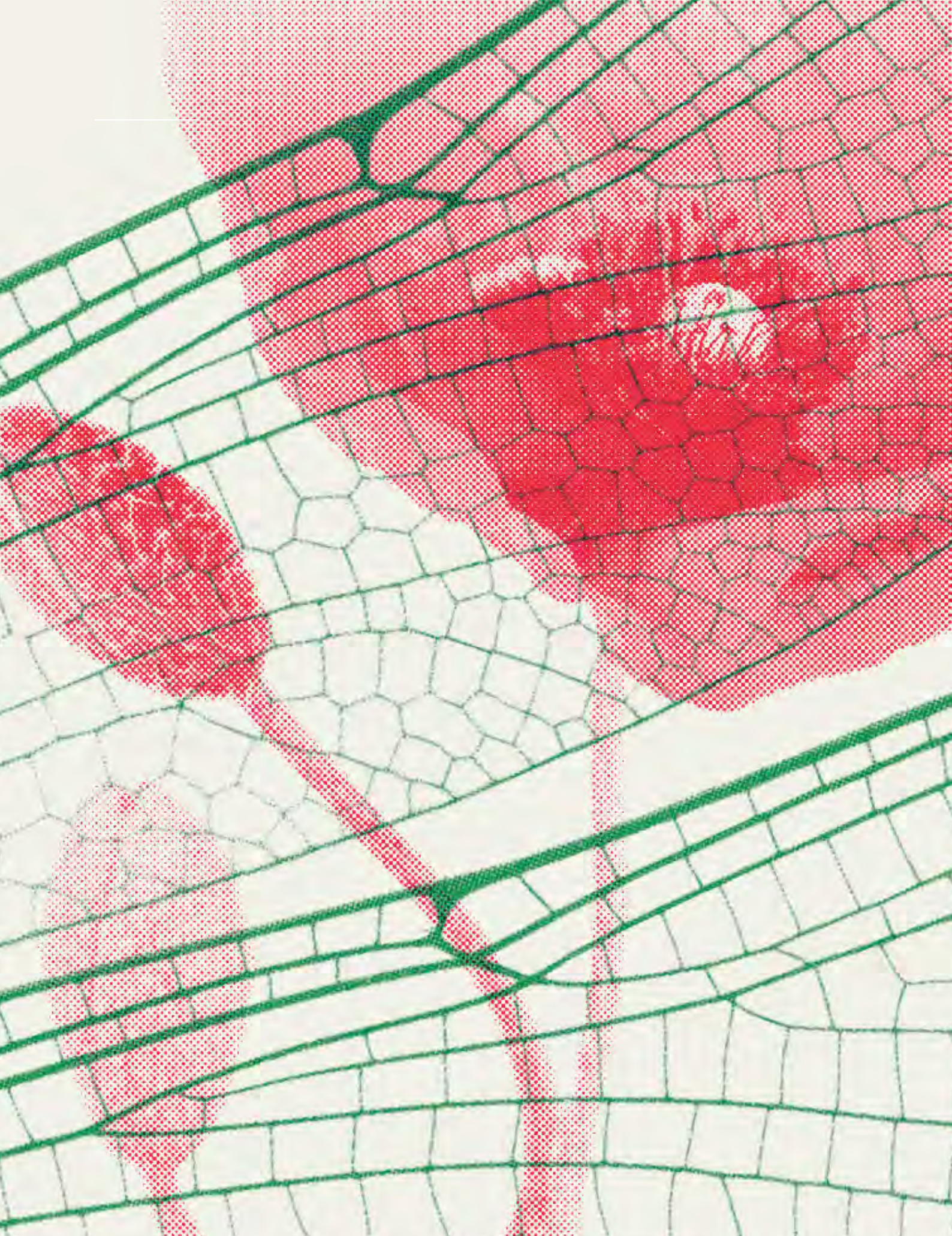

EXCHANGE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

An **official nomination** from the home university is needed in order to be accepted as an exchange student. Only nominations corresponding to the **study areas** indicated on the signed agreement will be accepted. Additionally, nominated students need to have the appropriate academic background and follow similar studies in their home university in order to be accepted.

Nominations must be done via the online form that will be sent to partners by e-mail. Please, **do not nominate Phd level or Traineeship** students through this form.

After nomination, students will be contacted by our office with instructions to register and complete an application at: sia.uab.es > Mobility and Exchanges > Incoming exchange students

The selection of subjects is done later. The Exchange Office at the host faculty or school will contact students directly. Any issues related to Learning Agreements should be addressed to the Exchange Offices.

* **Nominations for the Faculty of Medicine or Escola Massana** must be submitted during the first period, even if the students wish to apply for the second semester. Students will have to apply within the first period too.

ACADEMIC OFFER

General degree offer: Bachelors - Masters - PhD, Faculties & Schools

The availability of subjects must always be confirmed with the Exchange Office at the host faculty or school.

Not all the subjects will be offered or opened to exchange students. Exchange students must check the specific information for incoming students at each faculty or school. Check the requirements on the next page.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Lectures are **mainly taught in Catalan or Spanish**. There are subjects taught in English too. The language of instruction or any prerequisites are published in the Study guide of each subject.

For subjects offered in Catalan language, exams can usually be answered in Spanish or Catalan. Only the exams of the subjects taught in English can be answered in English if previously agreed with the lecturer.

Catalan and Spanish Language Courses

Exchange students have the right to enrol on an **Initial-level Catalan** course free of charge. Additional Catalan courses and all Spanish courses are also available and subsidised*. **In-person enrolment only**. Limited spaces. No reservation by phone or email is accepted.

Important remarks

- **Minimum 50%** of the total credits must be enrolled **at the host faculty or school** at UAB, which is determined by the exchange agreement signed with the sending institution. The remaining 50% of credits can be enrolled in a different faculty, but subjects from other faculties are restricted and upon availability.
- Depending on the faculty or school, the **selection of subjects** will be done on an **online pre-enrolment platform**. If that is the case, specific instructions will be sent by the Exchange Office at the faculty or school.
- The UAB is **not connected to OLA incoming**. Do not send Learning Agreements by EWP. The Exchange Office will indicate how to proceed.
- **Admission to master's level subjects:** It is only possible to enrol in university master's subjects if the agreement between UAB and the home university includes the master's level. Moreover, **the coordinator** of the Master's degree must give the **final approval**. Exchange incoming students at a master's level can enrol a maximum of 30 ECTS.
- **Thesis:** most faculties or schools **do not accept** students who intend to prepare their **final thesis project** at UAB or do some research for it. These cases must be discussed with the Exchange Office directly.
- **PhD and Traineeship mobilities: The International Relations Area or the Exchange Offices do not deal with incoming students who wish to carry out internships in the university.** In order to carry out a period of internship at the UAB, students should agree their acceptance directly with a department, library, research center, etc. Once accepted, an agreement and a Learning agreement will have to be signed between the student, their home university and the department receiving the student.
- **Complementary insurance:** Addressed to all students enrolled at the UAB. A small fee of 4,02 € (in 2025-2026) will be required in order to take out a complementary insurance that covers accidents and civil liability. Additionally, all incoming international students, researchers and professors must have their own medical insurance covering medical expenses referring to illness, accidents and repatriation.
